Dear Parents & Carers,

We are excited to welcome you to our Sports Day on Friday 26th June and would like to share a few messages before the day:

- Enter the School through Oakfield Road gate and walk to the Parents Zone. KS1 & EYFS come at 8.45am for 9am start and KS2 at 12.45pm for a 1pm start.
- You can bring a chair or a blanket to sit on.
- Always stay in the Parents Zone. The children will sit with their teachers. If your child becomes upset, please let the adults in school deal with this, you will be called if needed.
- Your children will be wearing their PE kit with their house colours, we would love to see you supporting the houses in those colours too.

- If you are bringing younger siblings, please ensure that they stay with you. It is going to be busy.
- We would rather you not use our toilets, but they are available if necessary.
- Like the children, please wear a sunhat, suncream and bring a water bottle.
- Please park sensibly so that we can leave school safely at the end of the school day.

Your actions influence the children. It's ok to be competitive, but please don't take this too far. Stay calm, cheer, and support all children. It is important that we respect everyone on Sports Day.

Warm Weather Forecast

1. We will be putting up gazebos for the children to sit under to provide the maximum amount of shade. Bring your own shade, if necessary, I suggest a personal umbrella that you carry with you and a hat.
2. Please can you make sure that your child has the appropriate sun protection, a water bottle and hat.
3. Due to the heat, there will be no parent or toddler races this year. This is so we can get the children back inside as soon as possible.
4. EYFS & KS1 parents, once Sports Day is finished please can you wave goodbye to your child so that we can take them inside and leave the school via the Oakfield Road gate.
5. KS2 Parents, if you would like to take your child at the end of Sports Day, we will release the children to you once they have been ticked off on the register by their class teacher.
6. I respectfully ask that there are no photos or videos taken during the event. Hawley Staff will use iPads and post pictures and videos to Seesaw for you to watch at home.
