ENTRY DATES TO EYFS 2023

Years ago Hampshire stipulated when children were to begin attending school full time; this was determined by each child's birthday so that, for example, a child born in October would attend full time from late September while a child born in July would attend full time from late November.

However, we are now allowed much greater flexibility so that each child's needs and experiences can be taken into account. As a parent or guardian you are now able to decide when you think is most appropriate for your child to attend school on a full time basis.

In making this decision please consider

- How mature your child is
- How easily they tire
- Their previous experience of a nursery or pre school setting (though please remember there a much higher adult to child ratio in these settings)
- How well they cope with changes to their routine

To help you decide upon this matter we have offered a 'New to EYFS' consultation with one of the Early Years Foundation Stage teachers on either **Tuesday 6th June or Thursday 8th June** (3.30pm – 5.30pm both days).
