Learning

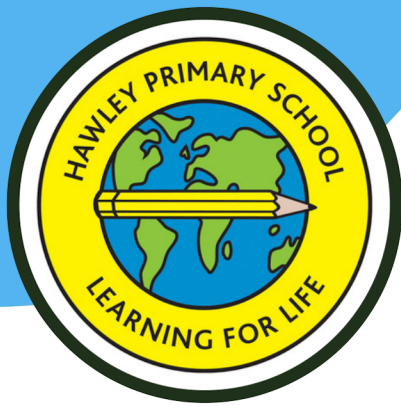
