Glossary

Axel – Is a rod that lets a wheel rotate.

Computing

Data is a collection of information gathered by observation, questioning or measurement. Data is often organised into groups. For example, shapes could be sorted by colour, size or even the total number of sides.

Once data is collected it can be represented in different types of graphs including pictograms. A pictogram is a chart that uses pictures or symbols to represent data so you don't have to look at lots of numbers.
