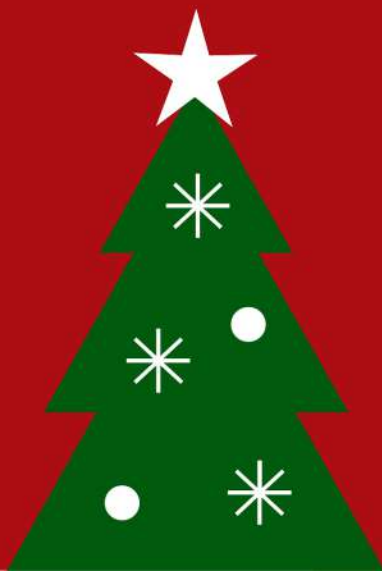

Merry Christmas!

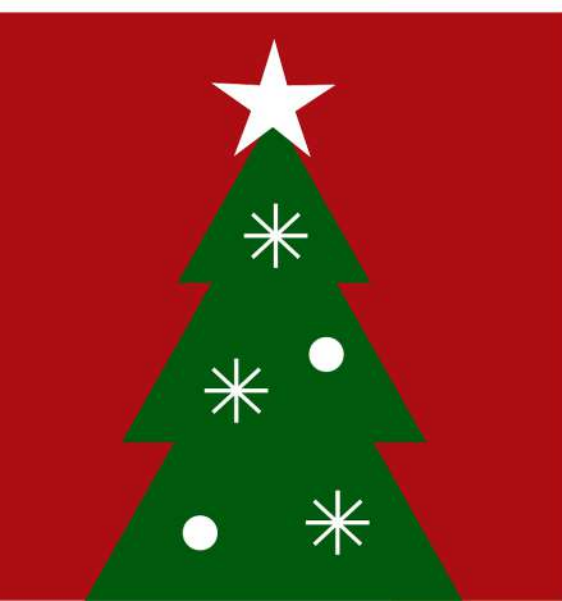

Well done everyone! 🌟

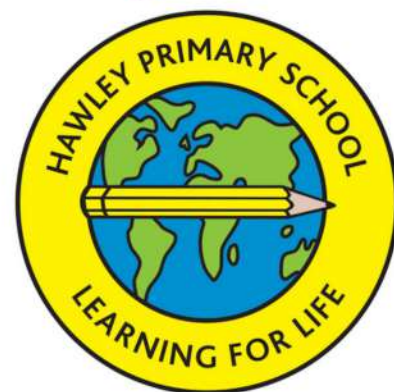

We are now the proud winners of a limited edition festive Team H-A-P that can be used by all classes to support learning. The video is on the school website.

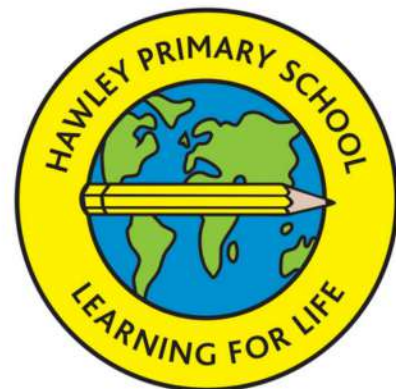
