

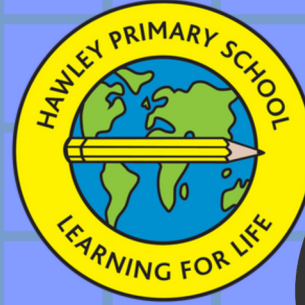

Golden Rules

We have six 'Golden Rules' that help us all get along:

- We are gentle
- We are kind and helpful
- We listen
- We are honest
- We work hard
- We look after property

These rules help make sure everyone feels happy and safe at school!

Why?

We are all one community: The Hawley Family. Our rules help us learn and play together in a calm, kind and caring environment where everyone feels happy, safe and secure.

When You Follow Our Golden Rules

When you make good choices, you might get:

- A compliment from your teacher
- Dojo points (when your class gets 1000 together, you earn a class reward)
- House points for great work
- Star of the Week certificate
- Over and Above Headteacher Award
- STEPS Award

'When you have a choice between kindness and negativity, always choose kindness.'

If anyone is unkind to you, or you see someone being unkind to others, always tell a trusted adult. We're here to help.

Be Kind to Each Other

Bullying means being deliberately hurtful to someone repeatedly. This includes:

- Being unkind or leaving people out
- Ignoring, gloating or not speaking up
- Hitting, kicking or taking belongings
- Name-calling or spreading rumours
- Being mean online

What Happens If You Break a Rule?

If you forget to follow our Golden Rules, here's what happens:

- Step 1: Your teacher will gently remind you about making a good choice
- Step 2: A private reminder about our rules and what you need to do
- Step 3: A last chance warning - your teacher will explain that reflection time is next
- Step 4: Reflection time - you'll have a few minutes away from the classroom to think about your choices and how to make better ones
- Step 5: If behaviour continues, you'll work in a different classroom/space
- Step 6: Your parents and Mrs Baker will meet to help you
