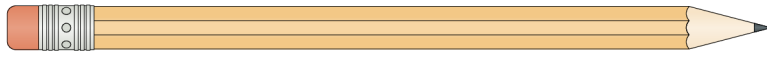


Parent /Carer Survey Results

What we're doing next:

Based on your responses, we will:

1. Streamline communication as much as possible so that messages are clear and in a timely manner. There is a monthly newsletter that celebrates our achievements, 'Hawley Headlines' is a weekly note from Mrs Baker, Headteacher and any other whole school admin messages will come via Arbor from Mrs Lody. Seesaw will be used to share classroom achievements and learning.
2. Review our after-school clubs provision so that they are varied and inclusive.
3. After the success of SEND parents evening slots in February, Mrs Smith will be hosting SEND information sessions for parents to discuss concerns and/or strategies

We'll keep you updated on our progress in future newsletters and will share the impact of these changes in our next survey.
